

Easy, Low-Cost, Non-Toxic Household Cleaners



Drain Opener**

½ cup baking soda
½ cup vinegar

Pour baking soda down the drain and follow with vinegar. Cover and let sit for at least 30 minutes. Flush with boiling water.

Furniture Polish*

1 cup olive oil
1/2 cup lemon juice

Apply sparingly with a rag to clean tables and other wood furniture.

Tub & Tile Cleaner*

1/2 cup liquid hand soap
1 1/2 cups baking soda
1/2 cup warm water
2 tablespoons vinegar

Mix all ingredients, stir until lumps dissolve. Place in a clean spray bottle. Use to clean bathroom, tub, and tile cleaning jobs.

Window Cleaner*

Club soda works great for cleaning windows and is completely non-toxic.

Countertop Cleaner*

1 cup water
1 cup white vinegar

Mix together in a clean spray bottle. Use to clean counter tops, stove top, and backsplash.

Toilet Bowl Cleaner**

Sprinkle toilet bowl with baking soda, drizzle with vinegar, let soak for at least 30 minutes and scrub with toilet brush.

Tip: Let ingredients soak for a while to make for easy scrubbing, especially on persistent stains like toilet bowl rings.
