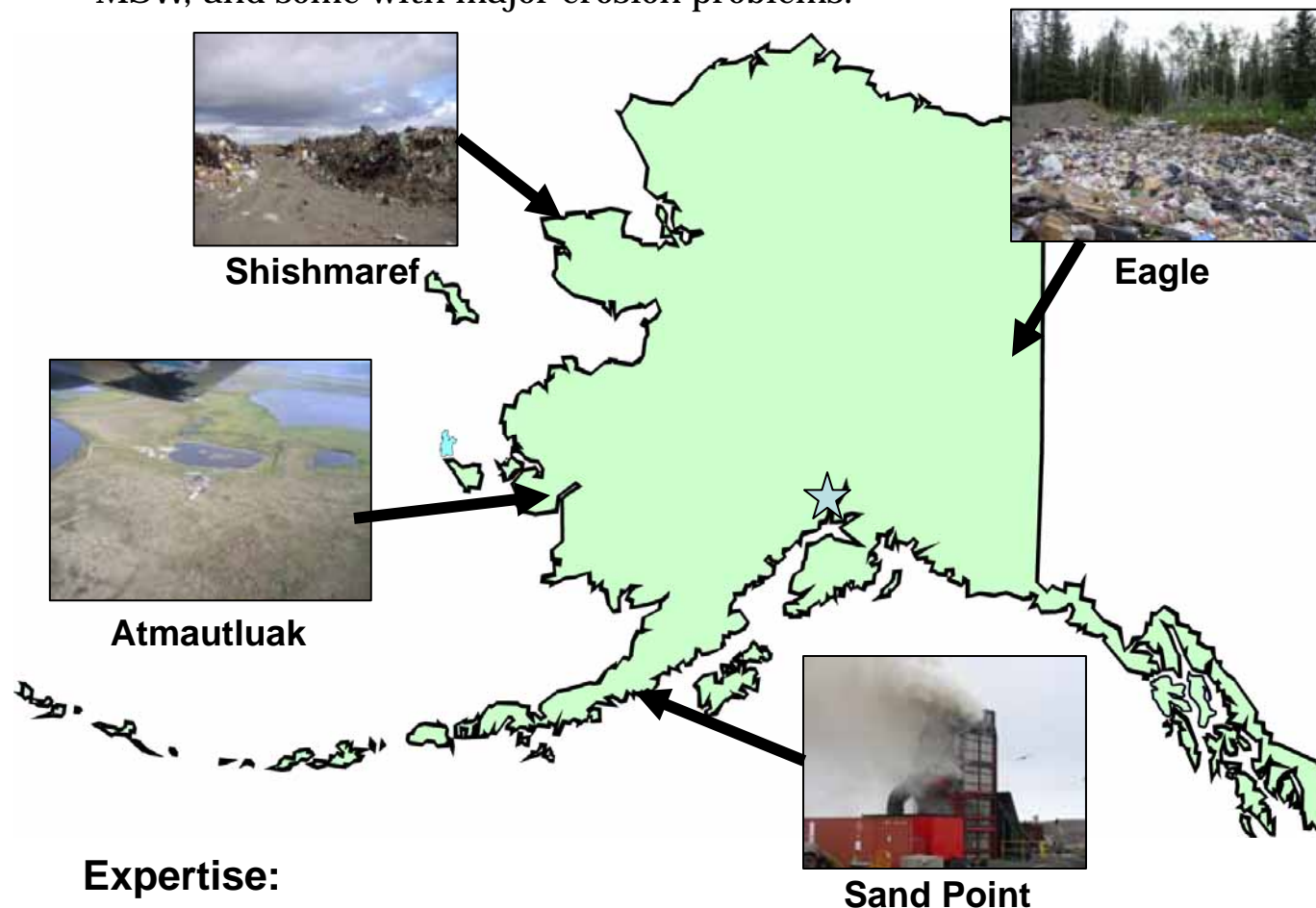
How can Ted help you?
